

TREASURER'S REPORT:

Mary gave the Kathy's treasurer's report as of November 9:

- Current balance on November 7: \$4187.94 \$574.00 = \$3613.94
- Expenses from award buckets, photographer, food for judges, padlocks for trailer, judges fees and airfare: \$1682.13
- Income from pleasure driving show and new family membership: \$1294.00
